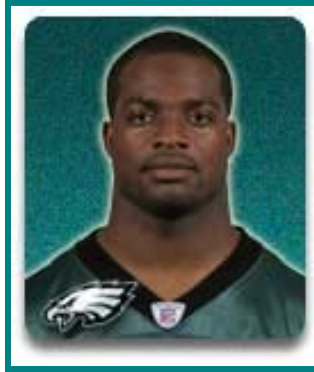




Thomas Tapeh, FB, Eagles



Joining the Pro Football Camp for his first year is Thomas Tapeh, starting FB for the Philadelphia Eagles. Thomas is a bruising back who can play fullback, running back, and contribute on special teams. He proved his blocking ability in 2006 by opening up holes for Brian Westbrook's career first 1,000 yard rushing season. Thomas also notched his first career touchdown on a pass from Donovan McNabb in a game against Tampa Bay.



His college career at Minnesota was a productive one, as he helped a high powered running game finish 3rd in the nation in rushing. His career stats included an impressive 24 TDs and nearly 2,000 yards rushing.
